GPA EXEMPT COURSES:

Students may take a GPA exempt class according to the following guidelines:

- 1. Junior and Senior students may take 2.0 credits each year for a total of 4.0 credits.
- 2. Student must have met the prerequisite to take the course.
- 3. Full-year courses will be exempted for the full year.
- 4. Students must complete the appropriate application form. The parent, student, and counselor must sign the form.
- 5. The application form must be completed and returned to the campus counselor by the designated date determined by campus administration.
- 6. Once the student signs up to take a course as GPA exempt, the decision cannot be changed.
- 7. Early graduates may submit a GPA exemption request for consideration on an individual basis.

EIF (REGULATION)

GPA EXEMPT COURSES:

McKinney ISD allows juniors and seniors to participate in the third and fourth years of the following courses on a GPA exempt basis. (Students must follow guidelines in EIC(REGULATION) to qualify):

- Athletics—Continuous enrollment for 3-4 years in any designated athletic course regardless of sport; does not include PE
- Fine Arts—Continuous enrollment for 3-4 years in band, color guard, choir, orchestra, theatre, dance/drill team
- Career and Technical Education—3rd or 4th course in a 4.0 course within a career cluster sequence
- Electives—Forensic Science, Principles of Technology, Advanced Animal Science, Engineering Math, Advanced Journalism II and III, Editorial Leadership, Debate III and IV, Student Government Leadership I, AVID III and IV, PALS I and II, JROTC III and IV
