MHS Golf Policies and Procedures

Policies

Workouts:

- 1. Required daily workouts
- 2. Workout clothing: Collared shirt, khaki pants, shorts or skirt. Golf course attire.
- 3. Proper behavior as defined by their coach. Any unacceptable behavior can result in suspension or dismissal from the program.
- 4. Players must provide their own transportation to and from practice and in some instances local tournaments.
- 5. Players must provide their own clubs.
- 6. In accordance with MISD policy, cell phone use during practice will result in the cell phone being confiscated and turned into their house principal.
- 7. No electronic devices will be allowed during scheduled practice times. No cell phones or headphones. They aren't allowed at tournaments.
- 8. Coach has final say on all dress and grooming issues. (i.e. clothing, hair, body piercings and tattoos)

Attendance:

1. Players are expected to attend all practices and workouts. If they miss any practice for any reason, they will be marked absent. It is the responsibility of the golfer to fix their attendance. Like any other class, you are either in class or you are absent.

Grading Policy:

1. Players will get a daily participation grade for each day. If they are at practice on time and participate 100% of the time they will receive a 100 for that day. If they are not at practice they will receive a 0 for that day. The player must text their coach and their parent, in the same text message the day of, in order to have the ability to make up the practice. If they do not text their coach and their parent, they will be unable to make up that practice. If they are late, for any reason, and are at 50% of the practice, they will receive a 50 for that day. Like any other class, if you miss an assignment it is a zero until it is made up. A golfer can make up a zero by playing 9 holes at a course, keeping score and having the pro in the pro shop verify and sign the score card. Once that score card is turned in the grade of zero will be changed.

Tournaments:

- 1. Players positions for tournaments are decided by their coach.
- 2. Players must travel to and from the tournament with their team. Any changes must have prior permission from the coach.

Lettering:

1. All players who are on the District Championship roster and finish the Season in good standing will letter in golf. Their first year playing in the District Championship, they will receive a letter jacket. Every year after they will receive a certificate of participation.
