

Girls Soccer Tryout Checklist

1. **Physical Examination: (MANDATORY)** A new physical is needed each year for an athlete to participate in athletics per UIL rules. We must have an up to date physical (dated April 1, 2022 or after) for every athlete by the first day of tryouts which are held during the first week of school. Preferably, this would be taken care of over the summer and turned in to us at camp. **The physical must be completed on the official MISD Physical Form.** These forms are located at the athletic office at Boyd that you may stop by and pick up as well.
2. **RankOne Online Paperwork: (MANDATORY)** The link to the required online paperwork is attached and the system is ready to go for next year. These forms must be completed before you come to us on the first day of school. Please be sure to sign your full name on the forms or they will not be accepted.

3. **Birth Certificate: (MANDATORY)** We will need a copy of your daughters' birth certificate on/or before the first day of school. This is also something that can be turned into us at camp. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO UPLOAD BIRTH CERTIFICATES TO RANKONE YOURSELF, THIS HAS TO BE DONE BY A PROGRAM COACH,** please email to ERAMOS@MCKINNEYISD.NET or you daughter can bring a hard copy to us.
4. **Proof of Residency: DO NOT UPLOAD PROOF OF RESIDENCY.** THIS WILL BE ASKED FOR CLOSER TO THE SEASON AND WILL BE UPLOADED BY THE COACHES. ALL PROOF OF RESIDENCIES UPLOADED BY PARENTS WILL BE DENIED

Tryouts will begin on the 3rd day of school in the Fall (Friday, August 10th). On that day, if your daughter has not completed their physical and/or online forms, they will not be able to tryout and will a request will be sent to their counselor for a schedule change.

We have two tryout periods. Initial tryouts are a week long at the beginning of the school year for a spot in the program (top ~65 – 70 kids). After this tryout athletes are evaluated over the entirety of the fall semester up until Thanksgiving Break to decide on placement for teams. **If an athlete is in another sport in the fall they will tryout at the conclusion of their season, MISD encourages multiple sport participation and athletes are not penalized for participation in other sports**
